

Brain Imaging Study of Hearing Loss in Children



Researchers at Boys Town National Research Hospital in Omaha, Nebraska are looking for youth aged 7-15 years old who wear hearing aids to participate in a brain imaging study of hearing loss.

Neuroscience researchers at Boys Town's Institute for Human Neuroscience are recruiting for a new brain imaging study of the effects of hearing loss on brain and cognitive development.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF **THIS STUDY?**

- To understand how our brains work during attention, memory and language tasks.
- To understand whether hearing loss affects **>>** how these processes occur in the brain.

WHAT IS REQUIRED?

- Undergo completely noninvasive brain » imaging with MEG and MRI
- Complete a battery of behavioral tests >>
- Have hearing and hearing aids tested 55
